- Will ask officials at each high school to select recipients based upon the Foundation's suggested criteria.
- We offer this award annually to a high school senior at the following schools: Camden, Canastota, Chittenango, Oneida, Madison, Stockbridge, VVS and Morrisville.

Criteria

The Selected Student Must Be:

- A graduating senior who is in above-average academic standing.
- Should exhibit academic and personal potential for a successful post-high school education.
- A contributing participant in extracurricular and/or community activities.
- Accepted into a 2-year or more undergraduate nursing or allied health program.

Priorities:

- Given to a senior accepted into an accredited college or hospital-based nurse training program.
- Allied Health students in the Oneida Healthcare Program.
- Students entering an accredited allied health program (excluding pre-medicine).
